

AGA Players of the Year for 2007

Last season, two outstanding golfers claimed Player of the Year titles. The AGA would like to recognize last year's top performers, Mike Vassil and Eric Williams. Both men are no strangers to the winner's circle, having captured most of Northeastern Pennsylvania's major championships.

Eric has long been recognized as one of our finest golfers. He qualified for last year's United States Amateur at San Francisco's Olympic Club. Eric and his father, Irv, a fine player in his own right, are members of the Honesdale Golf Club. Eric was able to best one of our area's finest senior golfers, Mike Vassil, as his 341.25 points allowed him to edge Mike's 339.46 points by the smallest margin ever!

A member of the Country Club of Scranton, Mike helped his team capture the 2007 AGA Senior Coal Scuttle with a fine 73 and a play-off victory over another fine senior player from Emanon CC, Len Coleman. Another 73 allowed Mike to finish in a tie for second at the AGA Mid-Am/Senior at Frosty Valley behind Glen Oak player Tom Gauntlett's 72. Mike finished with 532.50 points over Len Coleman who accrued a total of 239.75 points.
