2011 ANTHRACITE GOLF ASSOCIATION LAWLER JUNIOR TOURNAMENT INFO

***Important* Please read and complete all information, including parental permission signatures before mailing.**

The Anthracite Golf Association (AGA) will conduct two programs for junior golfers in the summer of 2011. AGA events are open to any boy or girl residing in Pennsylvania. Club membership is NOT a requirement. Registration must be done by mail. You must return a completed permission form with your application. Players must be registered at least two weeks prior to each event. Starting times and tournament results will be posted on this website. Applications are available at AGA member clubs, from high school golf coaches, and by downloading from the AGA website. Multiple applications in one mailing envelope will be rejected. All questions should be directed to the AGA office. Check the AGA website for starting times one week prior to the event. All our tournaments are conducted by AGA officials at AGA member clubs.

DIVISION II is designed for players aged 10 to 14 as of June 1, 2011, and who have some golfing experience. (9 hole events)

In addition to the age requirement, juniors **must** have previously played at least a few times on golf courses.

DIVISION I is designed for players aged 15 to 18 as of June 1, 2011, who can demonstrate established golfing ability. (18 hole events)

These are highly competitive tournaments at AGA member clubs. To compete in this program a junior **should** consistently score in the eighties or lower. This division is not intended for beginners. Participants with very high scores may have future applications withdrawn.

Can a younger player compete in Division I events?

The AGA recognizes that there are some very talented juniors under 15 years-of-age. The junior tour committee will consider applications to play in Division I from such juniors provided:

- 1) They enclose a letter signed by the both the player and a parent requesting permission to play in Division I.
- 2.) Submit a signed letter from a PGA professional or high school golf coach certifying a handicap of 15 or less.

This information must accompany the permission and application forms. The top five finishers in each event in Division I, subject to a performance evaluation, will be eligible to compete in our 2011 Tournament of Champions event to be conducted at Huntsville GC and Fox Hill CC. This final tournament consists of 36 holes, played over 2 days, with low scores determining the champions.

Dress, Conduct & Cancellation Policy

Soft spikes, dress shorts or slacks, and collared golf shirts are required at all AGA events. Juniors **MUST** walk and pull carts are **NOT** allowed. Parents and all spectators are welcome but must stay on cart paths and stay 75 yards from all competitors. ANY junior unable to keep a scheduled tee time **MUST** call the office at 570-383-GOLF or email the office and fully explain the situation to AGA officials. Very few circumstances are acceptable excuses for your absence. Transportation problems, participating in other sports, vacations and inconvenient tee times **ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE** reasons for absence. If you sign up for our tournaments, and we assign a tee time, you are taking a valuable spot that could easily be given to another junior who wishes to participate. If no call is placed, you will immediately be prohibited from playing in all remaining events for 2011, including the Tournament of Champions, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. If your reason is deemed not acceptable, you will be prohibited from playing in one or all of our remaining 2011 events, including the Tournament of Champions. Whenever **RULES SEMINARS** precede a shotgun start, you must attend the seminar.

Seniors who have played on our Junior tour are eligible to apply for thousands of dollars in AGA administered post secondary scholarships.
